2.Objective of the Practice:

The aim of the FINISHING SCHOOL is to impart all around personality development of the economically and socially backward students and instruct them in specific skills necessary in today's world.

3.The Context:

Indian society suffers from substantial inequalities in education employment. In spite of the increase in overall educational levels, the skills required to be professionally successful are still far from what is expected. A finishing school training program is a platform for students that emphasize training for all round personality development, cultural and social activities. Specific skill sets are imparted as value addition. The name reflects that it follows school or college education and is intended to complete the educational experience. Finishing schools aim at the standard improvement of individuals leading to stability among theoretical studies and realistic job experiences.

Finishing Schools offer many benefits for students and some of the key benefits associated with this area consist of developing presentation skills, communication skill, confidence enhancement, leadership and team skill, interview tips, success traits, incorporating spirituality etc. Students who join these schools will get a unique opportunity to attain the perfect stability between both theoretical studies and realistic job exposure.

4. The Practices:

Every year final year students are enrolled for the training program and the programs are arranged during the late hours or after course completion without effecting their normal classes. The following activities are done in the training program:

- (v) Networking and Communication Skills

5. Evidence of Success:

(a) Since its implementation, more than 190 students are successfully completed their training program on various soft skills.


(b) Feedback analysis after course revealed that students are found the course very valuable and they wish to recommend this course to other students. They wished to attend more such courses in future.

Executive Summary: Birjhora Mahavidyalaya was selected as one of the institutes in Assam to set up a FINISHING SCHOOL under the ‘**Equity Scheme**’ of **RUSA**, Assam.

The aim of the finishing school is to impart all around personality development of the students and instruct them in specific skills necessary to face the real world after leaving the college. These skills include soft skills, computer skills, knowledge based skills. The training has to be provided not only to the students of Birjhora Mahavidyalaya but also to the students of the neighbouring colleges


A four days training programme was conducted by RUSA, Finishing School Birjhora Mahavidyalaya to the final year students of the college. The program was formally inaugurated by Dr. Arundhati Mech, Coordinator, RUSA, Finishing School Birjhora Mahavidyalaya in the presence of the trained teachers and student participants of the course. Awareness and information about the initiatives taken up by RUSA to impart value addition to the academic learning of the students was given by the coordinator in her welcome speech.

The trainers imparted knowledge for different modules of the course. Topics covered were Spoken English, Application and Resume preparation, Communication Skills, Leadership and Team Skills, Power point preparation and presentation, Mathematics Aptitude, Group Discussion and Personal Interview.

Student Feedback was taken at the end of the course. Student participants spoke about their experiences during the program. They stressed on the benefits and motivational factor of the program.

Dr. Arundhati Mech delivered the vote of thanks.

Certificates were distributed to the participants at the end of the program.


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Participants: One Hundred Seventeen students from the different departments of Birjhora Mahavidyalaya were given the opportunity to attend the course.

Course Content

The course covered

1. Spoken English
2. Application and Resume preparation.
3. Communication Skills.
4. Team Skills
5. Leadership Skills
6. Computer Skills (Power Point Preparation and Presentation)
7. Mathematics Aptitude
8. Group discussion
9. Personal Interview

Methodology

Every session started with the objectives of the topic being stated clearly for the students. Lecture on various topics were given to the students. The lectures covered a particular skill- the meaning, importance, types and rules governing the topic were dealt with. This was followed by tips to acquire the same. Videos and Power Point presentations were part of the lectures. .

Interactive sessions and discussions followed, where the doubts of the participants were clarified. Ice breaking activities were conducted to make the students feel comfortable and make the training lively.

Demonstration of activities was given by resource persons as an aid to teaching. This was followed by participant activity sessions.

Students actively took part in the activity sessions. The resource persons gave verbal feedback pointing out the strong as well as weak points of the candidates immediately after the activity. The students were evaluated and their activities were analyzed by the trainers keeping in mind the different criteria. Assignments were also given and evaluated.

All the resource persons motivated the participants to acquire and develop the necessary skills.

Spoken English session activities consisted of an English speaking fluency game '*Just a Minute*' and '*Role Playing--- Conversations in a Market Place.*'

The Communication Skills session had activities had '*Draw the picture game*', which emphasized the speaking and listening skills and importance of body language and gestures.

The Leadership skill session and the Team skill session had team and leadership activities like," *Making shapes with a Rope*', "*Follow the Leader*" and "*Group tasks*" which tested various relevant soft skills

The Mathematics Aptitude class had the students solving various types of mathematics problems that come in job entrance exams. The solutions were discussed and doubts cleared on the same.

The Computer Skills activity consisted live demonstration of preparing a PPT and then tips were given on how to make a good PPT and present the same. Students were asked to prepare sample PPTs and present it.

In the Application and Resume preparation session the students were asked to prepare the same for mock interview for the posts of Research Assistant in Academic Institutes and officer in National Bank. The Personal Interview activity had mock interviews for the above post.

During the Group Discussion activity session , three rounds of group discussion was conducted on the topics

- a) *The flood situation in Assam- is there a permanent solution?*
- b) *Should Birjhora Mahavidyalaya, a purely Science stream college be upgraded to included Arts stream ?*
- c) *Red*

Throughout the program student volunteers assisted at different tasks like stage preparation, photography etc in an atmosphere of camaraderie and goodwill.

Besides providing a skill enhancement opportunity to the students the training program also gave a motivational environment to the participants to go ahead in their respective careers.

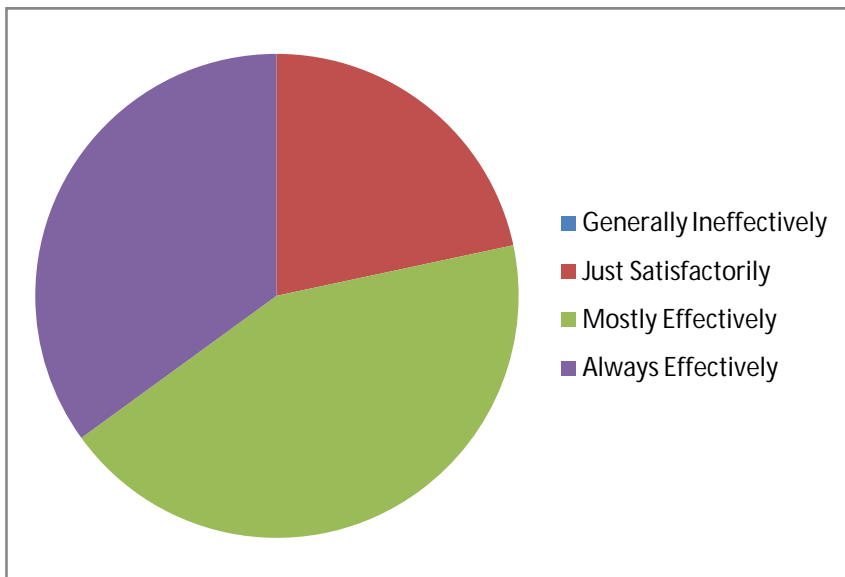
